## **MISSION**

The **StayWell Guam Diabetes Foundation**, a nonprofit organization, offers grants to patients in need of medications services and supplies.

## STAYWELL GUAM DIABETES

Assists eligible individuals with support in attaining access to medical services, supplies and prescriptions.

This program is funded by donations to the Foundation and support will be made available to all qualified applicants as funding is available. The current maximum annual funding amount per qualified applicant is \$250.

## QUALIFICATIONS

Financial assistance for services, supplies and medications are available through the Got Diabetes Grant Program.

### **You may be eligible for assistance if:**

- You have been diagnosed with diabetes
- You are a permanent, legal US Guam resident
- You meet income requirements
- You have receipts supporting your monthly expenditures for diabetes related services, prescriptions or supplies OR
- You have a physician's certificate of your diabetes diagnosis

These are just some of the eligibility requirements. The foundation may need additional information to make sure a patient is eligible for the program.

## HOW TO REQUEST THE ASSISTANCE YOU NEED

If you think you may qualify for the Got Diabetes Grant Program, contact the program directly to get an application. To apply, submit your completed application and the required documents. The Staywell Guam Diabetes Foundation does not charge a fee for participation. If you are approved, you will receive a notification in a few weeks.

If qualified a grant of \$250 will be issued for the purchase of either services, medications or supplies. All grants must be used for the purchase of diabetes related services and supplies indicated and prior to the expiration date noted.

The criteria for the dispensing of the grant will be on a first come first served basis. The receipt of a completed application plus all necessary supporting documents will be required to establish your place in line. That will be the sole criteria used to determine the order in which services and supply grants are issued. Incomplete applications will be returned.

## Follow the following steps

1. Contact the Foundation or download an application from our website.
2. Submit your completed application with any supporting documents—if you need help, please ask. We are here to help.
3. If you are approved, you will receive a notification within approximately 3 weeks.

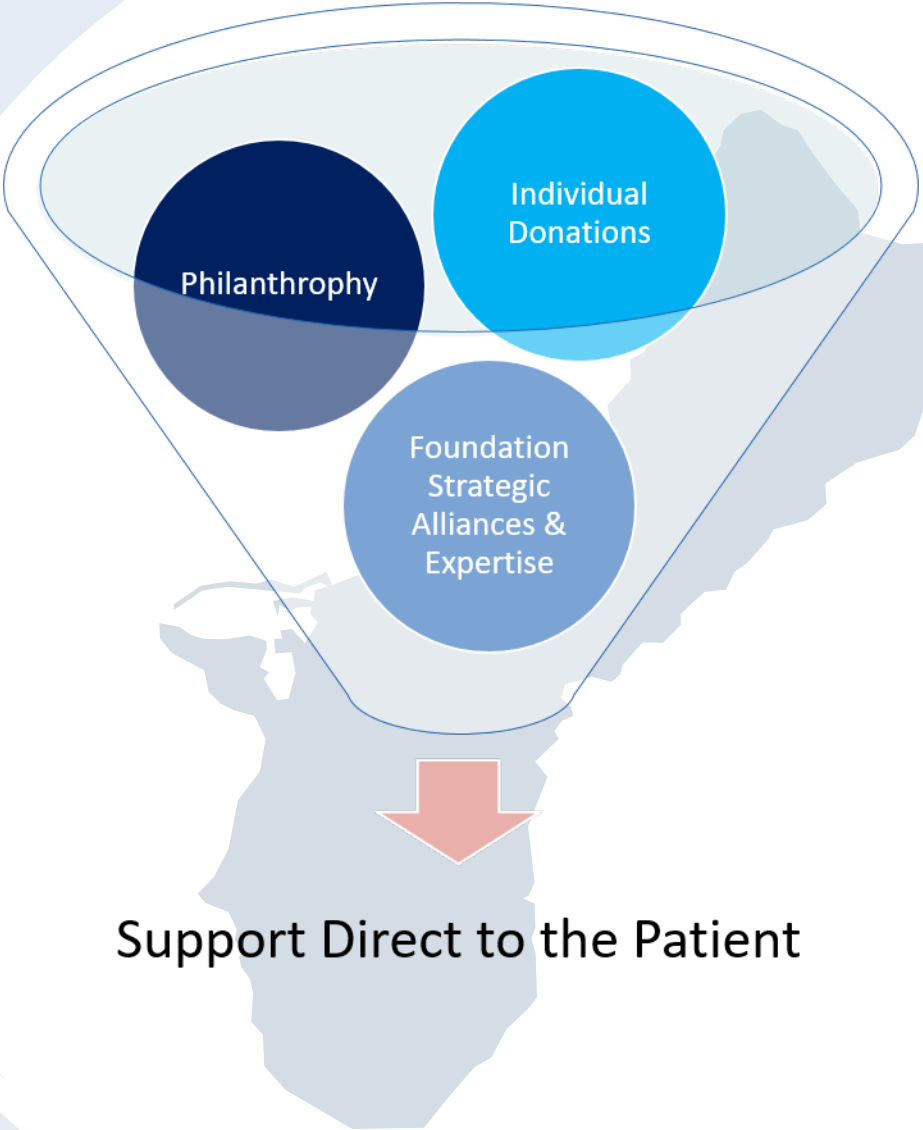
## Once approved

1. Grants will be issued with detailed instructions.
2. Please use the grant for diabetes related services, supplies and prescriptions prior to the expiration date.

## Special notes

- Grants will be issued on a first come first served basis.
- The receipt of a completed application establishes your place in line.
- Grants will be issued based on available Foundation funding.

## AVERAGE COST OF THE DISEASE

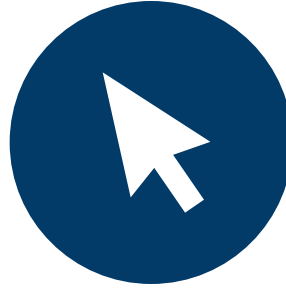
